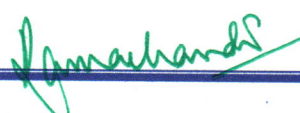
Analysis Report:

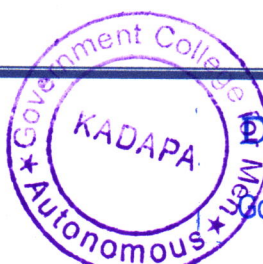
The following few lines are observed based on Alumni feedback on curriculum.

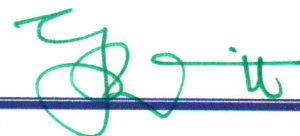
1. Alumni members are satisfied with the course content.
2. More Job Oriented courses need to be introduced.
3. Need based Curriculum updation is recommended.
4. Syllabus design and updation need to be mapped with more employability.
5. A few of the alumni have expressed that taking the expertise of alumni during the BOS meetings.
6. Some of them recommended that the new curriculum will make the students more market oriented.
7. The skill enhancement program in English and HVPE is recommended.

Action Taken Report

1. College developed a mechanism (Board of studies) to design and timely updation of curriculum by considering experts opinion.
2. One member from alumni is recommended to participate in BOS meetings.
3. The college is established JKC and placement cell to conduct campus job drives and to provide more placement opportunities.
4. College introduced 4 life skill courses and 13 skill development courses in the curriculum to improve the practical exposure on different aspects to meets the industry requirements and make the students are employable.
