- 5. A few of the alumni have expressed that taking the expertise of alumni during the BOS meetings.
- 6. Some of them recommended that the new curriculum will make the students more market oriented.
- 7. The skill enhancement program in English and HVPE is recommended.

Action Taken Report

- 1. College developed a mechanism (Board of studies) to design and timely updation of curriculum by considering experts opinion.
- 2. One member from alumni is recommended to participate in BOS meetings.
- 3. The college is established JKC and placement cell to conduct campus job drives and to provide more placement opportunities.
- 4. College introduced 4 life skill courses and 13 skill development courses in the curriculum to improve the practical exposure on different aspects to meets the industry requirements and make the students are employable.
