






8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth	No of Responses	% of Responses






















18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.	No of Responses	% of Responses
