Botany Museum

The department of botany was started in 1950. The department is equipped with two laboratories with one museum. Museum contains different scientific equipment and plant collections. Plant collections include herbarium and seed bank etc. All these articles are arranged and displayed systematically in glass cases and racks. Displayed collections are shown not only to botany students but also open to students of other courses & students of other colleges. Museum also contains around 150 charts and 250 slides.

The slides are mounted with microscopic plant of habit, vegetative, and reproductive parts. All these items are used for practical study or may be shown while teaching. Specimens are observed and studied when they are growing naturally. The specimens include several aspects of morphology, ecology, plant pathology, and other branches of plant science.
