Madan Mohan, BZC student of the college received Prathibha award for the year 2019. He was invited to deliver a talk to the UG students on career guidance.

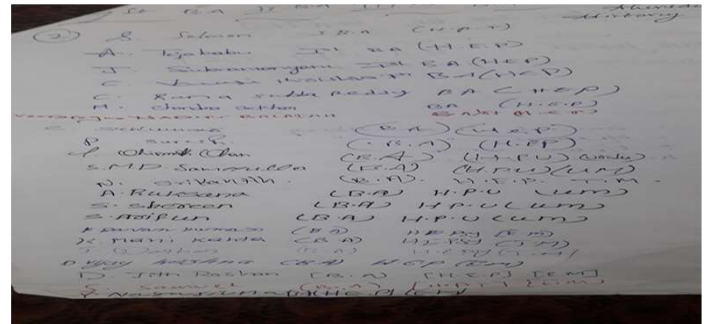
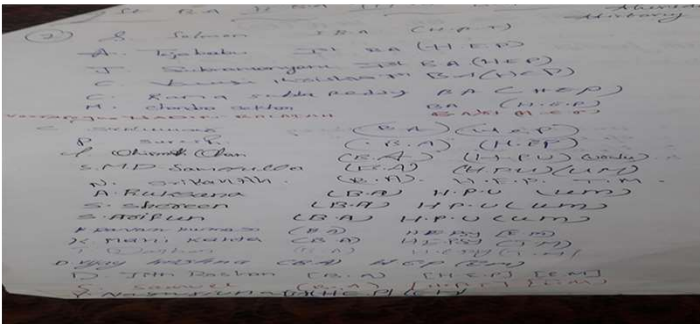
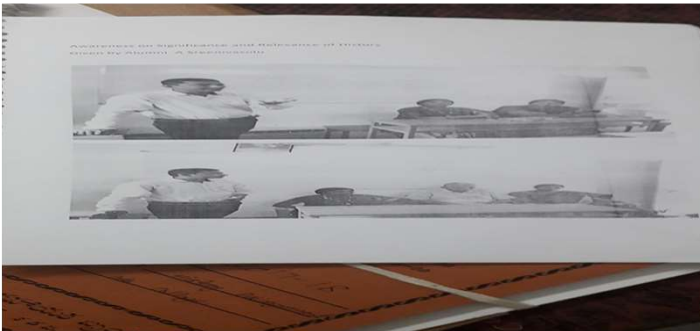
