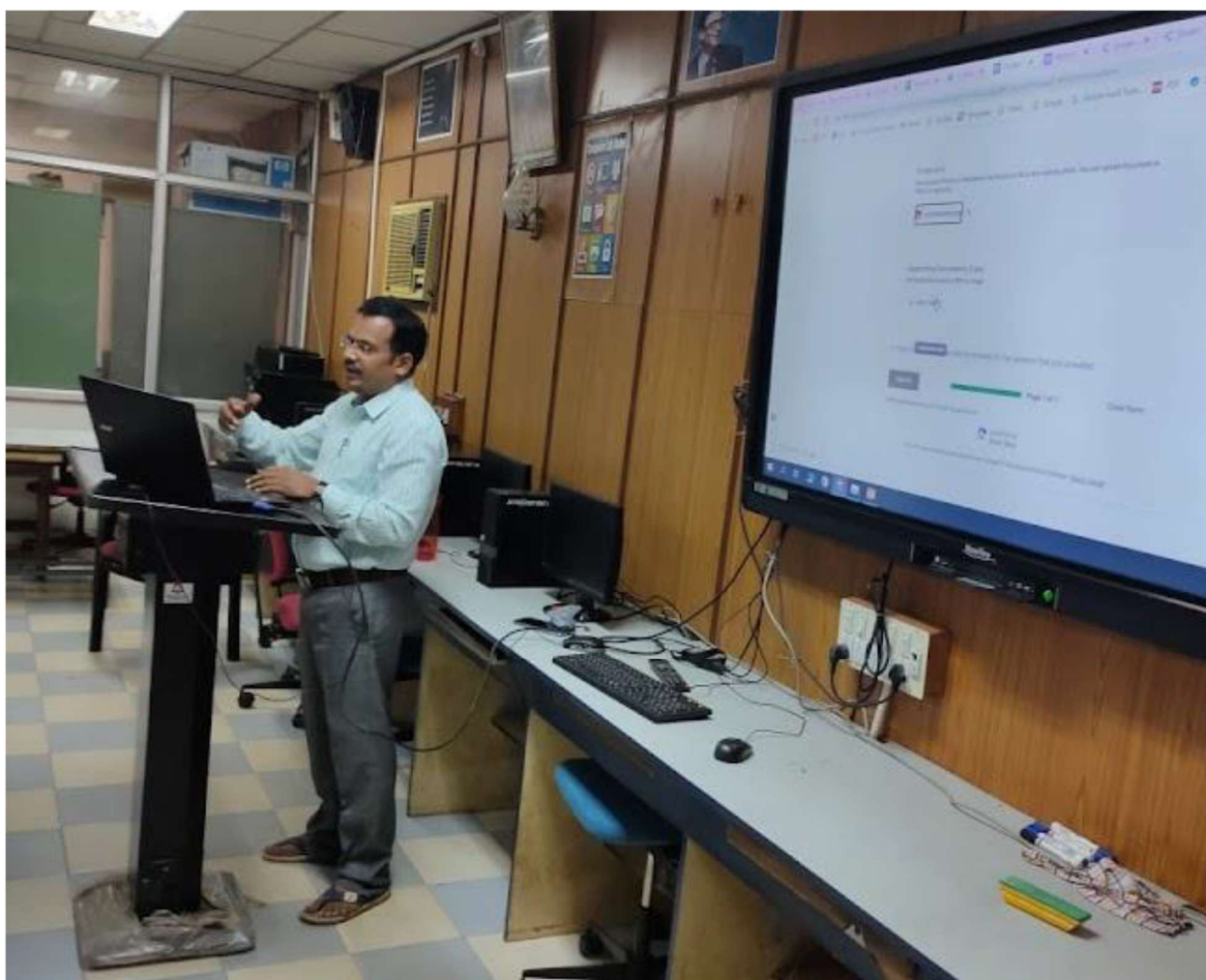

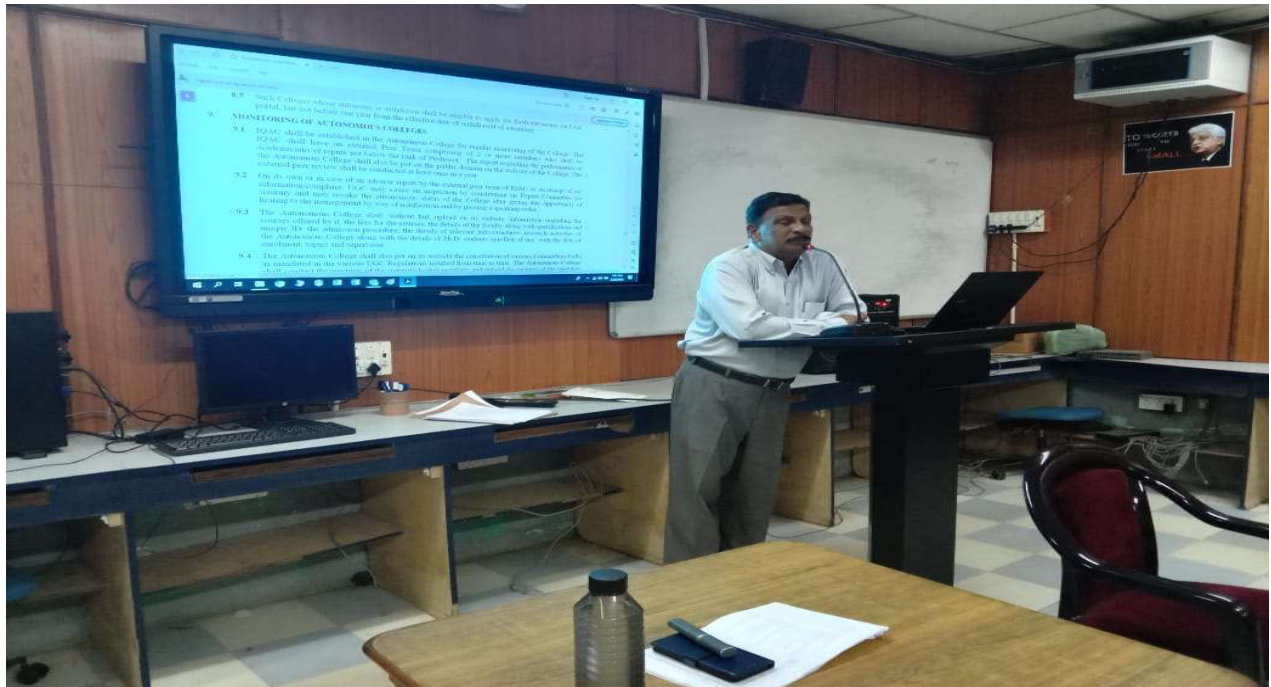
The principal of the college addressed the faculty to go according to the procedure prescribed to extend information systematically to face fourth cycle NAAC visit

- To translate it into action, IQAC conducted hands-on training programme and workshop for the faculty members on Online Data Collection and Auto-Generated Reporting System.
- Finally, the system has been implemented successfully in the college for collection of accurate, genuine and effective data. Then, the collected data is transformed to reporting format automatically using “Data Studio Software”.

Development of Online Feedback Collection and Real Time Analysis System

- One of the greatest challenges of autonomous colleges is to collect and analyze large amount of data from all stakeholders at different intervals.
- The IQAC has formulated” **Online Feedback Collection and Real Time Analysis System**”. In this system, the feedback was collected from the all stakeholders such as students, parents, alumni and employers on different aspects through Google Forms and analyze the data in real time by using “**GOOGLE DATA STUDIO**”.
- **Teacher Performance Evaluation:** The IQAC directly conducts teacher evaluation by students and the feedback is analysed. Appropriate corrective measures and reinforcement mechanisms are suggested on the basis of such feedbacks. Such constructive recommendations enable teachers to assess their teaching strategies and improve their academic standards
